Key information

- Spaces are limited so you must book in advance. Please call the booking number noted on the back page weekly, where you will have your place confirmed or be placed on a waiting list.
- Please sign the register at the entrance on arrival.
- We suggest a donation of £1 per family and all donations are reinvested in the Little Dolphins. If you feel unable to pay for whatever reason, please do not worry at all.
- You can leave your pram/buggy in the hallway leading into the church hall. Coat hooks are available.
- All Parents, Grandparents, Guardians and Childminders are responsible for the child(ren) in their care <u>at all times</u> during the session.
- Refreshments, toys, crafts and nursery songs/bible songs/stories will be available at each session. Please sit with your child during the singing time and encourage them to join in. If you want to lead a song or two, just let us know! We are keen this is a true group activity.
- Toilets and baby changing facilities are available inside the church building. If you forget something during a session please just ask.
- If your child(ren) have any infectious illnesses such as vomiting, diarrhoea, covid or chicken pox etc. then you must not attend until your health visitor or GP confirms when it is safe to return to group activities. The health, safety and well-being of all who attend Little Dolphins is very important to us and we need your help and cooperation to reduce any risk of infection to others, especially babies and pregnant women.
- In the unlikely event of a fire, fire alarms will sound and the volunteer team will direct you to the fire exits and the assembly point in the school car park.
- A first aid box is located in the kitchen and an accident book is maintained. In the event of an accident, volunteer leaders will advise of the group first aider.
- Relax, have fun and get to know each other!
